

2026 WESTERN PA SPEEDWEEK RULES

WEIGHT:

All racecars must weigh a minimum of 1425 pounds with the driver fully prepared to compete in the car throughout an entire event.

WINGS:

A standard maximum size of 25 sq. feet is permitted for the top wing. The top wing can contain a maximum 1.5" wicker bill located at the rear edge of the center foil. The front wing can contain a maximum 2" wicker bill mounted at the rear edge of the center foil.

Dished wings are **NOT** permitted. The center foil top is to be flat from front to back and side to side.

TIRES:

Hoosier tires are required on all four corners.

SAFETY:

Drivers must comply with each individual track's required minimum safety designations. Please consult with the various speedways for any questions pertaining to safety.

- Fire suppression systems are ***highly recommended*** all week.
- Six point mounting system for fuel cells are ***highly recommended*** all week.
- Front axle tethers are ***required*** at Pittsburgh's PA Motor Speedway and Lernerville Speedway.
- Front axle tethers are ***highly recommended*** at Mercer, Sharon, and Tri-City.
